Restricting Workers/Employees from Recreating Off Of Industrial Activities Clause

This clause remains unresolved and has not been discussed at length by the working group members or the Board as a whole. The potential need of this clause was raised near to the end of the WG's November 18th telecon and the following draft wording was developed.

Requires full discussion by the Working Group at its next telecon.

• Employees, consultants, contractors and/or others involved in an industrial activity may not access Crown land within the Muskwa-Kechika Management Area for the purposes of recreation, including hunting and fishing, while present on or near a work site or while travelling to or from that industrial activity.
